The Horse Guards barracks, built in the 17th century, lies just inside the Trophy Gate at Hampton Court, and flanks the main approach road to the Palace.

It is proposed to reorient the building and open some routes though which were lost in the 19th century. This will allow the development of an education centre with its own entrance, and a new introductory gallery in a building to be constructed between the barracks and a Victorian detention centre.

The first floor of the Barracks block will be used for classrooms and seminar rooms, reached by new stairs and a lift.
