The Jewish Museum currently operates out of two London sites: in Camden Town and Finchley. They have acquired a Victorian factory building in the middle of the block backing onto their Camden Museum, which is in a Listed terrace House.

Long and Kentish have been appointed through SOJEU procedures to carry through a major renovation/ restoration project linking the two buildings to form an important new Museum containing a designated collection of Jewish ceremonial art, and bringing on site the Finchley collections dealing with Jewish life in Britain.

The project has received approval for HLF funding. A contractor has now started on site and completion of the main contract is due in 2008. There will be a separate exhibition fit-out contract.

The museum opens in early 2009.
